



**Task 5** **Parents or Advisors Page** **30pts**

A list of support activities that parents can do to help increase student success.  
A list of advisors to your program or text or software parents might purchase for home computers or activities parents could do to enhance your learning in your class.

**Task 6** **Reserved Button** **5pts**

Your instructor will take care of the rest. I need this button reserved to put all the sub webs together at the end of our class. You can put your own link in this spot later.

**Task 7** **Standards** **30pts**

Load the district standards from our class library and select the sections you want to present on your site. A highlighted PDF will do or you can develop several linked pages to this page. The purpose of this page is to show how your class or classes support or fit into the established district standards.

**Task 9** **Syllabus** **30pts**

Present your course (s) objectives, outline, goals, benchmarks, activities, etc on this page. A concise statement should branch to more detailed information. This could be one long page with bookmarks or it could be several pages linked to this page.

**Task 10** **Assignments** **30pts**

You can prepare this page or pages in two ways. Use sample assignments put into PDF format or a listing of major assignments by weeks or by class day. Do not list assignments by dates. This causes too much maintenance.

**Task 11** **Awards** **25pts**

Show pictures of students getting awards, certificates, etc. Do not use last names when posting children's pictures on your site. News about your class in the media could be put on this page. In that case change the name on the button to **Media Coverage**.

**Task 12** **School Map** **20pts**

This page will show the school and the grounds where you teach and generally where your room(s) is located. Check in procedures will be stated for parents. Example: "Recent events in our country have caused a change in access to all public buildings. To insure the safety of our students and staff visitors follow this procedure..." Your instructor will provide the maps of your school and classrooms.

**Task 13** **Grades** **30pts**

Present information about student grades on this page. In general, when reports are made, what is your grading procedure and scale. This is a good place to make a statement about homework, reading folders, math bags, selected readings, extra credit, items sent home, items not sent home, etc.

**Task 14** **PowerPoint Button 1** **30pts**

This button will load your power point presentation. These can be about field trips, classroom presentations, home learning activities, drills on basic skills, etc. Examples are available.
