

Transitions II

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Transitions II is a course designed as a continuation of Transitions I. Students will prepare for the transition to post high school life by working on shopping skills, cooking skills, contacting adult agencies as necessary, learning community resources, and communication skills.

EXPECTATIONS
