



Work Experience

Work experience focuses on preparing students for the workforce of the future.

Course Description:

Work Experience is designed to help students deal with establishing and consolidating their identity, as well as deciding what they want to do with their lives. Exercises are offered that encourage students to take responsibility for their actions, demonstrate the rewards of delaying gratification, graphically illustrate the economic benefits of staying in school and off drugs, and more. Once the students have practiced their employment skills, they are encouraged to find a part-time job of their interest. Work experience fosters good employment skills such as punctuality, hard work and a work ethic that prepares the student for permanent employment after high school.

Student's Responsibility

It is the student's responsibility to seek employment in a part-time job of his/her interest. The student must apply for the job, interview, and obtain and maintain a job for the entire quarter. If a student has already obtained a job, he/she must continue in the employment for the quarter and follow all school and employment guidelines. Each quarter, a job questionnaire will be given to each employer and must be returned by the student to the Work Experience Coordinator.

Grading Procedure

Work Experience is taken on a pass/fail basis. To pass the class, a student must obtain and maintain employment, follow all school and employment guidelines, and submit a summary of their employee performance completed by their employer at the end of each quarter.
